**1. The program:**

**4. Eligibility:**

Non Sri Lankan citizens who are undergraduates or graduates or those who have completed secondary education successfully at the time they apply.

## 7. Selection of courses:

Students are required to select minimum 04 courses to maximum 06 courses from the BBA and/or MGT courses in any combination across 100 to 400 levels.

## 8. Learning:

- (a) Duration of teaching per 03 credit course per semester is 45 hours (30 hours of lectures and 15 hours of discussion classes).
- (b) Students are required to attend lectures together with local students for the courses they have selected.
- (c) The minimum number of attendance is 80% of the total teaching hours to obtain the 'eligibility' for sitting the final examination of a course registered.
- (d) According to the 'Sri Lanka Qualifications Framework' notional learning hours per taught course per one credit are set at 50 inclusive of teaching hours.

## 9. Examinations:

Examinations are held by way of continuous assessments and final examinations. Results are approved at the Board of Examiners of the Faculty of Management.

## 10. GPA calculation:

The GPA for each student is calculated using the formula  $GPA = \frac{\sum c_i g_i}{\sum c_i}$ , where  $c_i$  and  $g_i$  are respectively the number of credits and the grade point for the  $i^{th}$  course.

## 11. Award of the certificate:

Certificates are awarded by the Vice-Chancellor of the University.

## 12. Course fee:

Course fee is calculated on the basis of credit value and at the rate of US\$ 50.00 per credit. This is a composite fee of tuition, examinations and the transcript. Additional transcript shall be issued at a fee of US\$ 10.00. Students are required to pay the fee in full based on the above rate at the point of enrollment as a Summer Student at the Faculty of Management. Refund of course fee is not considered.

### 13. Registration:

Prospective students may apply for the Summer Program by filling the application form downloaded from the Faculty Web and sending it via e-mail or by post. Selected candidates are given 'Prior Registration' and shall be duly informed.

### 14. Other considerations:

- (a) It is the responsibility of the students to obtain Visa for this purpose. The Registrar of the Faculty of Management shall issue a letter for those who have already obtained 'Prior Registration' which may be helpful for them to obtain Visa.
- (b) If a candidate wishes to reside on campus, they shall have to pay a dormitory fee on monthly basis in addition to what he/she pays as the course fee.

### 15. Online application for course registration:

Candidates are required to fill this application form to obtain the 'Prior Registration' for the Summer Program. However, candidate on his/her arrival at the Faculty of Management could reconsider the combination of courses and resubmit a fresh application for proper registration.
