Reference lists are created to readers to locate original sources themselves. Each citation in a reference list includes various pieces of information including the:

- 1. Name of the author(s)
- 2. Year published
- 3. Title
- 4. City published
- 5. Publisher
- 6. Pages used

Generally, Harvard Reference List citations follow this format: Last name, First initial. (year published). Title. City: Publisher, Page(s). (Extracted from: http://www.citethisforme.com/harvard-referencing)
