The faculty proposes an annual research excellence award with the aim of promoting its academic staff members to conduct and disseminate research by recognizing their excellence in research.

Application Process

- 1. Applications will be called by the Dean of the Faculty of Management.
- 2. Applications should be forwarded to the registrar of the faculty through the Head of the relevant department.
- 3. Applications should be submitted with the evidence for the marks claimed.
- 4. A three-member panel including at least one external member appointed by the Faculty Research Committee (FRC) evaluates and selects the awardees.
- 5. The decision of the panel of evaluators will be final and therefore, appeals against the selection decision are not considered.

6. The faculty board approves the list of selected awardees.

Eligibility and Award Criteria

- Candidate should be a permanent academic staff member of the Faculty of Management.
- 2. Research published/presented within the previous year from January to December will be considered.
- 3. Papers accepted for publication but not yet published will not be considered.
- 4. Marks will be allocated proportionately for joint papers published based on the awardees' contribution.
- 5. Points allocated for research contributions are as follows.
