



The session aimed to provide training to the academic staff members in order to deliver the ERP course modules to the undergraduates of the Faculty of Management, University of Peradeniya.





FACULTY WORKING PAPER SERIES – AUGUST 2022

Faculty of Management, University of Peradeniya

The fifteenth session of the "Faculty Working Paper Series" conducted virtually on August 03, 2022. Ms. Thakshila Kumudumali from the Department of Operations Management, Mr. Ranura Perera from the Department of Human Management, and Resource Darshana Bandara from the of Marketing Department Management made the presentation based on the title, "Degree of Effectiveness of Virtual Learning Mode in Sri Lanka: With Reference to State Universities in Sri Lanka". The was reviewed by Mr. paper A.M.A.S.M. Bandara from the Operations of Department Management. The event was graced by the Dean, Heads of Departments, and Academic Staff of the Faculty members Management. A brief abstract of the paper is given below:



The COVID-19 pandemic has forced educational institutions around world to close down and put their academic calendars in jeopardy. To keep their academic activities alive, most educational institutes have switched to virtual learning platforms. This study investigated quantitative determinants of postgraduate students' success with their virtual learning experience at Sri Lankan state during universities the COVID-19 pandemic.



Research Questions and Objectives

Primary Research Question: Do Sri Lankan postgraduates are satisfied with their online learning experience?

Research Questions:

- 1. Do the conducive environment, progressive mindset and facilities provided by the university effect on postgraduates' success of learning from home?
- 2. Do Sri Lankan postgraduates prefer for online learning in the future?

Research Objectives:

- 1. To determine the satisfaction of Sri Lankan postgraduates with their virtual learning experience.
- 2. To identify the impact of the conducive environment, progressive mindset and facilities provided by the university towards the postgraduates' effectiveness of virtual learning.
- To emphasize the preference of Sri Lapkan postgraduates on virtual learning in the future

This quantitative study investigated the determinants of postgraduate students' success with their virtual learning experience at Sri Lankan state universities during the COVID-19 pandemic. The data was collected from 180 postgraduates mastering various courses related business administration at state universities in the country.

The findings emphasized that the Progressive Mindset and Personal Qualities of Learner exerted the strongest effect on students' success in learning, implying the crucial need to develop the facilities provided by universities for the effectiveness of virtual learning. The study supports creating and ensuring the longterm sustainability of productive student-friendly virtual and learning spaces in higher education in the new normal.

FACULTY OF MANAGEMENT

The Faculty of Management is the ninth Faculty at the University of Peradeniya, established in 2015. Even though the Faculty of Management at the University of Peradeniya is only seven years old, the University of Peradeniya is the pioneer in Management higher education in the country as it has been offering a Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.) Degree Programme since 1962. At present, the Faculty of Management offers a Bachelor Business Administration Honours Degree Programme under five areas of specialization related to five Departments and caters to about 175 university entrants who sat their G.C.E. (Advanced Level) examination in the Commerce stream each year. In addition, it also offers two inter-faculty degree programmes, namely, B. Com. and B.Sc. in Computation and Management, in collaboration with the Faculty of Arts and the Faculty of Science, respectively.. Apart from the internal programmes, the Faculty offers a BBA External Degree Programme online and a in Management Diploma Development programme through

the Centre for Distance & Continuing Education (CDCE) of the University of Peradeniya. Furthermore, the Faculty of Management Within seven years of its existence, the Faculty has achieved the highest grade (Grade 'A') offered by the Assurance Council University Grants Commission (UGC) for its BBA Degree Programme. Recently, the Faculty has also won the AHEAD grants worth of Rs. 120 million through which a and a computer constructed, and furniture, equipment, and learning materials were purchased to promote outcome-based education and learner-centered teaching.

As part of the strategic plan, the Faculty of Management intends to expand portfolio in line with the development taking place in the industry by introducing new degree programmes at undergraduate as well as postgraduate levels. For this purpose, the Faculty plans to train the develop staff and its physical infrastructure to provide students with adequate knowledge and facilities to transform them into high-quality graduates.
